

WORKFORCE ASSISTANCE

Our Business Development team conducts ongoing outreach and visits with local companies to better determine workforce assistance eligibility and to aid with the grant application process.

Existing Employees

Incumbent Worker Training (IWT) Grant

- Businesses may use a public, private, or in-house training provider based on the nature of the training
- No employee wage restriction
- Reimbursable training expenses can include instructor wages, curriculum development, materials, and textbooks

Employed Worker Training (EWT) Grant

- Trainees must be existing, full-time employees at time of training, with wages that do not exceed \$26/hour
- Reimbursable training expenses can include instructor wages, curriculum development, materials, and textbooks
- Training must result in a certification or certificate of completion

New Employees

Florida Flex

- Program is customized, flexible, and responsive to individual company needs
- Employee wages must be at least 125% of the average wage in Florida
- Reimbursable training expenses include instructor wages, curriculum development, materials, and textbooks

On-the-Job Training (OJT) Grant

- Employers are reimbursed up to 50% of an eligible employee's wage for up to the first 10 weeks of employment
- Eligibility of applicants will be determined by CareerSource Tampa Bay

Screening and Recruitment Assistance

- Assistance with recruiting potential candidates via social media, job fairs, and other onsite recruitment events
- Posting of open positions to Employ Florida Marketplace
- Screening potential applicants to ensure candidates are qualified
